SUBJECT: Special Representative to the Northern Mariana Islands-U.S. Negotiations

Attached for your signature is a letter to Pedro Tenorio, Governor of the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, informing him of your designation of Becky Norton Dunlop, Deputy Under Secretary of the Interior, as the President's Special Representative to the talks between the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands and the U.S. to identify and resolve issues that need to be addressed. Governor Tenorio has requested this letter.

Also attached for your signature is a letter to Mrs. Dunlop designating her as your Special Representative to these negotiations. You announced Mrs. Dunlop's appointment on May 13, 1988. She is leaving for the Northern Mariana Islands on August 25, 1988.
